WELCOME TO CAMP!

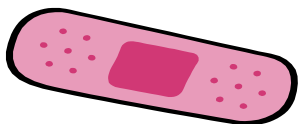

CAMPER HEALTH & MEDS



A registered nurse is on camp staff, and is available 24 hours a day. A doctor is as near as Mount Vernon (4 miles).

If a camper has prescription medication that she will need during camp please send it in a labeled zip lock bag in the original prescription bottle. It will be collected and kept in the nurse's station. It will be dispensed by the nurse until the end of camp. **PLEASE DO NOT SEND TYLENOL OR IBUPROFEN.** It is provided in the Nurse's station.

If the camper has been exposed to a contagious or infectious disease in the two weeks prior to camp, she regrettably will not be allowed to attend.

LOST AND FOUND

We ask each camper to LABEL ALL BELONGINGS! All items left at camp will go to the **Greene County Association Office** located at **834 W. Battlefield**, in Springfield. After three weeks, anything unclaimed will be taken to Grand Oak Mission.

PHONE

A phone is available at Baptist Hill for emergencies only. Due to the number of girls at camp, please do not expect your child to call. Parents may call the camp office to check on their daughter at any time (417) 466-3358. Do not call your daughter's cabin leader during camp, they are busy taking care of their cabin of girls and cannot spend time on the phone. If there is any kind of problem, you will be notified.



VISITORS

We are happy to welcome visitors during Worship on Monday night from 7:00 to 8:15 p.m.; and during the final Worship time on Friday from 11:30 a.m. to 12:15. Please limit your visits to these times. No meals will be provided for our visitors.

CHECK-IN FOR GIRLS CAMP

Girls' camp registration will start at **12:30 p.m.**, on Monday, July 24. Please be ready to follow instructions for drop off and registration of girls when you reach Baptist Hill.

Please leave all camper belongings in the vehicle until registration is complete. Cabin assignments will be provided at this time. Parents and registration persons may help carry belongings to cabins.

Please be sure campers know who will pick them up and please make sure all belongings are off the bus for girls staying at camp. When leaving, exit out the back gate.



HEAD LICE POLICY

Please check your child's head or have a professional check her now and then again a few days before camp. All campers' heads will be checked the first day of camp before any belongings are unloaded from the church vehicle. **Girls will be asked to take their hair down so it can be thoroughly checked.**

No girl will be accepted on the first day of camp with live head lice or nits for ANY reason.

CHECK-OUT FOR CAMP

Check out will begin at 12:45 on Friday, July 28. Everyone will be busy, so please don't plan on picking up your camper(s) early. You may load camper belongings after they are dismissed from the cafeteria at 12:45.

Parents and persons picking up girls are welcome to attend the final Worship Time at 11:30 and lasting until 12:15 p.m. The girls will then have lunch and be dismissed at 12:45.

Once again, entrance will be through the front gate. Please exit through the back gate.

ATTIRE: Baptist Hill Staff ask that we strictly adhere to the following:

- Modest shorts, capris, or jeans may be worn.
- Halter tops, spaghetti straps, translucent clothing, miniskirts, or apparel that exposes the midriff are **NOT** to be worn at any time.
- Modest 1-piece swimsuits without cutouts are acceptable. ANY other type of suit will require a t-shirt worn over it.
- Casual dresses, skirts, long or Capri pants and tops are to be worn to supper and worship.
- When going to and from the pool, campers must wear a modest cover-up or shorts & t-shirt over swimsuit.

- **Closed toe shoes are recommended.** Remember that Baptist Hill is a camp and the ground can be rough and rocky.
- No t-shirts or other clothing depicting alcohol, drugs, non-Christian rock groups, tobacco products, or questionable language, please.
- Please do not feel like you need to bring any “fancy” or “special” clothes, such as DRY CLEAN ONLY to camp.

Items NOT to bring: phones, ipods, MP3 players, radios, CD players, video games, gum, extra food, fireworks, weapons, alcohol, tobacco or illegal drugs. If your daughter brings any of these items we will keep them for her until the end of camp.

2-3 outfits for worship
active clothes (tops & shorts/pants)
Underwear (panties/bras/slips/etc.)
Socks
Sturdy shoes (for daily wear)
Old tennis shoes (to get wet at the spring or while canoeing)
Swimsuit & knee-length cover-up (and a dark t-shirt if suit is 2-piece)
Old clothes for messy activities

Sunscreen
Light jacket or sweater
Rain gear (poncho or umbrella)
Sit upon (carpet square / rug for sitting in the grass)
Reusable water bottle
Plastic bag (for wet clothes)
Dirty clothes bag

BE SURE TO LABEL EVERYTHING!

OPTIONAL

Money for mission offering and souvenirs from the gift shop (\$1-\$20)

Camera and film (disposable cameras are best – please label!)
Flip-flops for the shower

Medications in original prescription bottle, in labeled zip lock bag
Flashlight



CANCELLATION POLICY
